## Commissioner Tours Children's Medical Daycare

MERCER COUNTY, NJ – New Jersey Department of Human Services Services Commissioner Kevin M. Ryan visited the children at Mercer County Children's Medical Daycare (MCCMD) in Hamilton, NJ recently and spoke with the staff about the importance of adequate medical care for New Jersey's vulnerable children. Commissioner Ryan said "It is our job to ... keep children safe and heal the scars of trauma; integrate persons with disabilities into our communities ... and to respect and affirm the humanity of persons living with disabilities and illness."



Sue Viola, President of MCCMD, supports the Commissioner's efforts to reaffirm community providers' efforts to ensure safety and medical wellness to vulnerable children under 6 years old. "It is all of our responsibility to ensure that New Jersey's children are not only afforded complete access to much needed healthcare services, but also provided safe, nurturing environments in which to grow and learn."



Mercer County Children's Medical Daycare provides children with special medical needs, ages birth to 4 years, with a continuum of medical care that is prescribed by their doctors in a daycare environment. The program opened in July 2003 as the State's largest pediatric medical daycare program and has served over 170 children from the Trenton community.
