Center caters to chronically ill kids

HAMILTON — A day-care center for preschool children with ongoing medical needs has opened at 100 Youngs Road.

In addition to offering educational activities, Mercer County Children's Medical Daycare is equipped and staffed to provide children with medical care prescribed by their physicians, said Michelle Bunting, president of the for-profit facility.

The center can administer treatments for more than 30 different medical conditions in "a stimulating day-care environment," according to the center's advertising.

Newborns up to 4-year-olds are accepted. The center is open nine hours a day, five

days a week, and transportation is offered, Bunting said.
